

# Inquest into the deaths arising from the Lindt Café siege

## Order made by the State Coroner on 13 May 2016 with respect to public interest immunity claims made by the Commissioner of Corrective Services New South Wales

With respect to the public interest immunity claims made by the Commissioner of Corrective Services New South Wales (“**the Commissioner**”):

1. The following claims made by the Commissioner, are upheld, as likely to disclose intelligence or endanger inmate safety:
  - a. the 14<sup>th</sup> word at the entry at 10:47am of the document titled ‘Police Operations Centre handover running log of Assistant Commissioner Michael Fuller’ (Tab 11.9);
  - b. the ninth and tenth words at the entry at 1:00pm on page nine of 11 of the document titled ‘Police Operations Centre handover running log of Assistant Commissioner Mark Murdoch’ (Tab 13.10);
  - c. the ninth and tenth words at the entry at 1:00pm on page 9 of 11 of the document titled ‘Police Operations Centre handover running log of Assistant Commissioner Mark Murdoch’ annexed to the statement of Sergeant Frances Aliprandi (Tab 15.18); and
  - d. the following information contained in the statement of Detective Sergeant Vicki Reid (Tab 15.19):
    - i. the ninth and tenth words at the entry at 1:00pm on page 9 of 11 of the document titled ‘Police Operations Centre handover running log of Assistant Commissioner Mark Murdoch’ annexed to the statement of Detective Sergeant Vicki Reid; and
    - ii. the ninth, tenth, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> words at the entry marked ‘Intel’ on the penultimate page of the handwritten notes annexed to the statement of Detective Sergeant Vicki Reid.
